

TKA SANCTIONED RULES

SPECIAL TOURNAMENT RULES REGARDING KUMITE

Make sure your divisions are separated into either novice or advanced. If there is a large number of participants in a division, the division may be split into 2 or more groups. This will be at the discretion of the Tournament Coordinator or Director.

KUMITE COMPETITION

Contact: Light contact to face, back of head, kidney, chest or torso and groin in all divisions

Equipment: Groin Cups, Punch and Kick Pads, Headgear and Mouthpiece required by all divisions

Face shield is Mandatory: For all Junior Kumite Divisions, optional for Adult Kumite Divisions. Mandatory for ALL Junior & Adult Chanbara Divisions.

Chest Protector is Mandatory: For all Junior divisions 11 years old and under.

Out of Bounds Rule: Definition of "Out of Bounds" Both feet touch outside of the designated ring perimeter (does not include fighting out) if both feet go out of bounds with no contact, it becomes a penalty point.

Coaching: Coaching from parent/instructor is allowed as long it is respectful. Parents and Children can be disqualified from competition for disrespectful behavior.

POINT SYSTEM

- 1st place 10 points
- 2nd place 7 points
- 3rd place 5 points
- 4th place 3 points

Bonus Points: If a participant competes at every event at the end of the season, he/she will receive an additional 10 points.

ALL PARTICIPANTS WILL RECEIVE A MINIMUM OF 2 POINTS
