Light (touch) face contact Adult Brown & Black Belts.

No face contact for Youth, Adults Novice, Adult Colored Belts and Senior Kyus.

Equipment: Traditional uniforms (sleeves past elbows, No T-Shirts)
Foam Safety equipment (head, hands, feet) is required for all Sparring divisions. All Sparring and Chanbara divisions require mouthpieces for all competitors, and Groin protection for all male competitors.

Trophies: Beautiful trophies for First, Second, and Third place Winners. Medals for all youth kata competitors.
All First place Forms Winners qualify to compete for Grand Champion Awards.

Beautiful Grand Champion awards for Black Belt Forms, Black Belt Men Sparring, Black Belt Women Sparring, Adult Kyu Forms, and Junior Beg., Int. & Adv. Forms.

2 Special Team Awards: one for the school with the most competitors and one for the School that earns the most points (3 points for a first place; 2 points for a second place; 1 point for a third place; & 4 points for a Grand Champion.)
